

Members in Good Standing 2021/22

The Olive Oil Commission of California has issued its list of Members in Good Standing for the 2021/22 California olive oil harvest and milling season and is pleased to report that all companies who produce 5,000 gallons of olive oil per year or more have achieved the “Member in Good Standing” status. This list can be used as a guide to help customers purchase olive oil with confidence.

To be recognized as a Member in Good Standing, companies must meet the following requirements:

- Participation in the mandatory government sampling and testing program.
- Labels used on products have been verified as accurate through independent chemical and sensory laboratory analysis.
- Assessments for participation in the program have been paid in full.

The program is designed to ensure California olive oil is correctly labeled with respect to quality. Members in Good Standing are allowed to use the OCCC logo on their bottle indicating they are in compliance with the OCCC’s testing program. Each year this list is made public to provide buyers with a guide to purchasing quality California olive oil.

The program is open to smaller producers who wish to participate in sampling and testing on a voluntary basis. The names of both mandatory and voluntary members who meet all requirements of the OCCC program are published each year.

Olive oil sourced from outside of California by the brands on this list is not subject to the mandatory testing and sampling program of the OCCC.
